Perimeter School—A Leader Among Leaders

Whether you are a new or veteran Perimeter School parent, you may have heard the word *ChildLight* around here from time to time. But, what does this title mean? Since our school just hosted a conference with 11 schools represented from 5 states, some as far away as Colorado, and an internationally known speaker from the UK, it seemed like a great time to give an update. Let's start at the very beginning...

After its founding in 1983, Perimeter Christian School began to start and facilitate the formation of other schools at the various Perimeter Church campuses in the Atlanta area. These unique covenant schools were inspired in part by the philosophy of education eloquently explained by Susan Schaeffer Macaulay in her book, For the Children's Sake. This book highlights a model of Christian education built around the philosophy of Charlotte Mason, which focuses on the premise that a child is born a person and is an image bearer of Christ. As we all should know, since we have read her books, Susan Schaeffer Macaulay is the daughter of the late Francis Schaeffer. (One little known fact that Susan shared with me at a conference at the Charlotte Mason College in 1999, is that her book, For the Children's Sake, has sold more copies than all of her father's books combined!) Born in South Africa in 1936, Ranald Macaulay was converted from atheistic existentialism within a week of his arrival to study law at Cambridge. He married Susan Schaeffer and they had 3 children of their own, and also suddenly and unexpectedly "inherited" 2 extra children (ages 3 and 7) for whom Ranald and Susan were designated guardians when their parents were tragically killed.

When Perimeter Church divided into separate churches around Atlanta, an association of schools at those 4 locations remained along with Crossroads Christian School to form the Perimeter School Association (PSA). These schools met regularly to encourage one another and to share ideas and best practices. In 1993, a small group of PSA educators met with

Susan Macaulay at a conference and began to fan the flame of implementing Charlotte Mason's educational philosophy in contemporary education. Gradually the emphasis on applying new ideas and refining the older ones increased in all the schools.

In 2003, PSA chose to broaden its membership from only covenant schools to include schools and school educators who are committed to the educational philosophy of Charlotte Mason as understood and applied from her writings. The name *ChildLight Schools* (CLS) inspired by Susan Macaulay was chosen for this new association¹, now with a website, representation in 5 states, and a dozen schools. The desire of the *ChildLight Schools* is to continue to grow and serve one another in keeping the truth of sane and inspiring Christian education alive and well.

As the main visionary in this movement in the United States, Bobby Scott, calling upon his longtime relationship with the Macaulays, organized this year's *ChildLight Schools* conference around Ranald's heart cry: *Rekindling the Vision*. Those of us who were blessed to be in attendance experienced a profound and prophetic discussion of the intersection of Christianity and philosophy through the ages. We can now join with Ranald and his non profit organization, *Christian Heritage,* whose goal is to "demonstrate to contemporary society that Christianity was and is a living faith with the power to change people and therefore to shape history." May God be praised as we share with our students and with you as parents and friends this shared missional vision.

Special Message from Bobby Scott Regarding Future Head Lice Procedure (all grades)

I know all of you applaud our School Nurse Karen Lemon for her extra effort in dealing with our unusual health issues this year. However, in regard to our recent practice to check the ENTIRE school for lice, this was commendable but it is <u>not</u> to be our future arrangement. We would like to have Karen retain a sound mind and be a part of our school! Our procedure will be simple:

- If by your own inspection or that of an outside party, it becomes apparent that your child has lice or nits, <u>you</u> are to contact the school nurse. This is appropriate as we are a covenant family. (a link to methods of proper inspection and treatment will be provided to you)
- 2) We will make it known to the parents of your child's class only that a case exists. There should be no stigma with this...it is not a health hazard or disease and can be picked up in numerous ways. Chill.
- 3) After treatment, our school nurse will be required to check that lice and nits are eliminated <u>for the child to</u> <u>return to school</u>.

This should catch your interest! ANY Fulton County registered voter may VOTE EARLY - REGARDLESS OF WHERE YOUR USUAL FULTON COUNTY VOTING PRECINCT IS. The closest location to Perimeter Church is at the <u>Northeast/Spruill</u> <u>Oaks Library on Spruill Road</u> (Turn right onto Old Alabama from Perimeter Church, Spruill Road/Library will be approx 1 mile on your right). Dates/times are: Monday, Oct 27th - Friday, Oct 31st from 8:30am-7pm. During advance voting, you may vote in the regular manner showing one of 6 forms of photo ID. You may vote here even if Spruill Library is NOT your usual voting precinct location.
