### 1 Thes. 2:7-12

<sup>7</sup> But we proved to be gentle among you, as a nursing mother tenderly cares for her own children.

<sup>8</sup> Having thus a fond affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us.

<sup>9</sup> For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, how working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.

- <sup>9</sup> Be hospitable to one another without complaint.
- <sup>10</sup> As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
- Whoever speaks, let him speak, as it were, the utterances of God; whoever serves, let him do so as by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.
