1. On Mission

2 Corinthians 5:14-15

¹⁴ *For the love of Christ controls us, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died;*

¹⁵ *and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.*

Galatians 2:20

²⁰ *"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.*

2 Corinthians 5:15

¹⁵ *and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.*

2 Corinthians 5:17

¹⁷ Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

**2) Allegiance To God's Kingdom Assumes A Change In What We Do.
(2 Cor 5:18-21)**

2 Corinthians 5:18

Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation,

2 Corinthians 5:19

namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 5:20

²⁰ Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

2 Corinthians 5:21

²¹ He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
