Exodus 5:22-23 (NASB)

²² Then Moses returned to the Lord and said, "O Lord, why hast Thou brought harm to this people? Why didst Thou ever send me?

²³ "Ever since I came to Pharaoh to speak in Thy name, he has done harm to this people; and Thou hast not delivered Thy people at all."

Exodus 6:28-30 (NASB)

²⁸ Now it came about on the day when the Lord spoke to Moses in the land of Egypt, ²⁹ that the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, " I am the Lord; speak to Pharaoh king of Egypt

all that I speak to you."

1. God Has A Plan

Exodus 7:1-7 (NASB)

¹Then the Lord said to Moses, "See, I make you as God to Pharaoh, and your brother Aaron shall be your prophet.

² "You shall speak all that I command you, and your brother Aaron shall speak to Pharaoh that he let the sons of Israel go out of his land.

³ "But I will harden Pharaoh's heart that I may multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt.

⁴ "When Pharaoh will not listen to you, then I will lay My hand on Egypt, and bring out My hosts, My people the sons of Israel, from the land of Egypt by great judgments.

⁵ "And the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring out the sons of Israel from their midst."

⁶ So Moses and Aaron did it; as the Lord commanded them, thus they did.

⁷And Moses was eighty years old and Aaron eighty-three, when they spoke to Pharaoh.

2. God's Plan Has A Purpose

1) To Prove Himself As God

Exodus 7:5 (NASB)

⁵ And the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring out the sons of Israel from their midst.

2) To Display His Power

Exodus 9:16a (NASB)

^{16a} But, indeed, for this cause I have allowed you to remain, in order to show you My power,

3) To Proclaim His Name

Exodus 9:16b (NASB)

^{16b}... and in order to proclaim My name through all the earth.

Philippians 1:12-14 (NASB)

¹² Now I want you to know, brethren, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the gospel,

¹³ so that my imprisonment in the cause of Christ has become well known throughout the whole praetorian guard and to everyone else,

¹⁴ and that most of the brethren, trusting in the Lord because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.
