

Global Outreach

Thanks to the generosity of Perimeter Church's congregation and in partnership with Kingdom Investments, Global Outreach has followed the lead of the gospel by:

- Mobilizing or sending people to serve overseas
- Taking care of the least and the lost especially widows and orphans
- Mercy and justice
- Developing leaders of the global church through Life-on-Life Missional Discipleship using Jesus' model, methods, mandate and mission.

Response to World Wide Crisis

Global Outreach provided relief work after the hurricane in Haiti, the tsunami in Japan and the earthquake in Guatemala.

China

Working with the China Partnership, Kingdom Investments has provided accelerated training for church planters in numerous major cities throughout China. This three-year initiative was named Grace to the City.

Egypt

We provided funding for supporting more than 2,000 Syrian refugee families living in camps in several North African countries. Funding provided medical, food, clothing, shelter and comfort.

Guatemala

Community Outreach provided medical and dental equipment, medicines, doctor care, treatment of wounds, by providing vehicles, and accommodations for several short-term mission trips.

- Funded start-up costs for a **Child Protection and Restoration Program** for children in abusive situations providing therapy for the children and their parents.
- Building more than 380 new homes for people whose homes were destroyed by an earthquake.
- **Breaking the poverty cycle** by providing a holistic approach including spiritual, academic, and vocational education to enable emotional, financial, and physical health.
- Supported the **Mona de Vida School** which provides food, clothing, Christian and academic education, vocational training, and recreational facilities for about 260 children in the city of Escuintla.

India

- Pastor Training Center: Built and maintained a pastor training center for pastoral education and the vocational training necessary for pastors to support their families as they build their church congregations.
- Draught Relief: provided the drilling of wells in more than 50 villages that did not have a clean drinking water supply.
- **Balwadi Schools:** Support seven Balwadi schools in Mumbai slums for pre-education. The schools provide nutritional food, clothing and a Christian education. It enables the lowest cast children an opportunity to gain entrance into the government school system.

Poland

- ProNovis House Church Planting Movement: Through the work of Gospel Joy which includes music concerts,
 Bible studies and potential leader identification, new house churches are being planted in several Polish cities. In
 a predominately Catholic country Christian house churches are better equipped to serve the growing Christian
 community, versus the traditional brick and mortar church structures.
- **ProEcclesia Church Intern Leadership Program:** This program develops new church leaders through training, internships in existing churches to provide the leadership necessary to grow the Christian church in Poland.

Tanzania

Tanzania School is one of the most successful schools in the country of Tanzania. It has been a model for other schools and for the government of Tanzania to recognize as the best. This school system provides scholarship to deserving student to attend secondary and university schools. KI has provided funds for the building of the school, a library and other school related projects. Perimeter Church sends Perimeter School teachers to Tanzania on a regular basis to provide teacher training and introduction of new educational materials and methods.

Thailand

- Nightlight International Foundation: Projects include the support of a "Safe" house for women taken in off the street. Nightlight provides safety, food, and training in a trade so the women can support themselves and those that were brought to Thailand from other countries are then supported by Nightlight to gain re-entry into their home country. Nightlight works with many proactive governments in getting these women back to their native countries. Nightlight has built several businesses (such as jewelry-making, a bakery, coffeehouse, and screen printing) that employ these women. The purpose of these businesses is to teach the women a trade and to provide employment. As the women go through this life transforming program they are introduced to Christ and attend church worship services daily.
- Santisuk Foundation: This foundation runs a school in the worst slums of Bangkok. There are approximately 350 children in the school. KI has participated in the expansion of the school by providing matching funds for additional classroom construction.
- Jaisamarn Church: KI has providing matching funds for the rehabilitation of this church's facilities for a growing congregation. It reaches out to the local slum families through children's programs which then bring the parents into the knowledge of the one living God. This church is located in the worst slums of Bangkok. It not only serves its local congregation but also mobilized 30 other churches during times of crisis, such as during the floods of 2014. In addition, KI has provided funds for the Blessings House, which is used to house homeless families, widows, and the disabled, until they get back on their feet.
- Church for the Deaf and Blind: KI assisted Jaisamarn church in converting the rooftop of their church building into an environment to house worship services for the deaf, blind and homeless.

Life-on-Life Missional Discipleship (LOLMD)

Initial startup funds were provided to start LOLMD movements in Australia, Brazil, China, Ireland, and South Africa. Today each of these countries have a thriving LOLMD movement led by disciple-making churches. Country-by-country LOLMD updates are as follows:

- Australia: Approximately 30 Australian churches are in the final phase of the four-phase process in starting a LOLMD movement called the "Empowerment Stage." This means that the churches in Australia are now giving LOLMD away to other churches in other cities. They conduct their own teaching clinics that are in the second or Establishment Phase and further coaching and equipping the churches in the third or Equipping Phase.
- Brazil: This is an amazing story of how God works in choosing people to do his work. Global Outreach began teaching more than 20 large churches in San Paolo, Brazil several years ago. Despite all of our efforts and resources the movement was not happening. Then one small church in the City of Goiania took up the calling. This one church now leads the charge throughout six states in the country, which includes more than 80 churches. They have been in the Empowerment Stage for more than three years. They conduct their own teaching clinics and coaching training and invited Randy Pope to speak at a National Discipleship Conference in September, 2016. Churches from all over Brazil were invited.
- China: As a result of the church planting movement supported by KI in China, Perimeter Church was invited two years ago to begin holding LOLMD clinics in Wenzhou for 20 churches. The success of this endeavor initiated the planning of another movement in several other cites to begin in 2017. God willing, this could be a tremendous Chinese church-led movement to change the hearts of the Chinese people. (This is a closed country, so we don't advertise this.)
- **Ireland:** In 2010, we began working with a few churches because Ireland had experienced a tremendous shift away from the Catholic Church but also away from religion of any kind. We are now seeing church in Ireland and Northern Ireland coming together to begin the movement in major cities like the capital cities of Belfast and Dublin.
- **South Africa:** In 2010, Global Outreach, supported by KI, began working with a small handful of disciple-making churches. Initial efforts were not as productive as we hoped. But today, the churches in South Africa are in the Empowerment Phase teaching LOLMD clinics to additional churches in other cities outside of Johannesburg.
- Finally, movements are well underway in Cuba, India, Poland, Philippians and Singapore.
