Perimeter Badminton Community (PBC) Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's):

(Revision 9-27-2018)

1. What is Perimeter Badminton Community (PBC)?

- > PBC is a **community group** within Perimeter Church Get Connected/Community Ministry. Through the **sport of badminton**, PBC participants get connected to one another and to Perimeter Church.
- > PBC is open to Perimeter Church members/regular attendees and the community at large.
- ➤ PBC is for <u>recreational badminton</u> and not for <u>competitive badminton</u>. Hence PBC is not part of any badminton league.

2. When does PBC meet and where?

- Meeting times/place:
 - Wednesdays and Sundays: 6.30 PM -10 PM (subject to change)
 - Perimeter Church Gym, 9700 Medlock Bridge Rd, Johns Creek, GA 30097

3. How does one join/be a part of PBC?

- **Regular participation** in PBC is through **annual registration** during September-October.
- ➤ PBC is limited to <u>50 registered participants</u> (maximum #) for the ministry year September August
- When maximum # of registrations has been received, registration will be closed and additional interested participants will be place on a wait list for future enrollment based on available "opening".
- > Occasional participation (or guest participation) is welcome on Wednesday sessions only and/or at discretion/invitation of Person in Charge (PIC) without registration.
- Perimeter Church member/regular attendee is given priority to be a registered participation.

4. What are the benefits of becoming a regular (registered) participant of PBC?

- Access to practice badminton regularly at PBC during ministry year September August
- Priority registration to be part of the 50 registered participants during annual registration.
- > Get connected to Perimeter Church and its resources for the community through **Taste of Perimeter**.
- Get answers to perennial issues of life through Investigative Forum and other church sponsored community events/seminars/classes.

5. What is the fee for being part of PBC?

- > There is no fee to be part of PBC.
- > During registration, participant is asked for <u>voluntary contribution</u> to help meet the expenses of resurfacing the gym floor as part of its regular maintenance.
- Minimum suggested contribution is currently set at \$240/per ministry year, payable to Perimeter Church.

6. What are the basic rules governing the practice sessions?

- Practice sessions are based on first come first serve basis.
- > Each player is to sign his/her name on the Play List while waiting for an open court.
- ➤ He/she may pick a four-some for the next open court.
- A re-match is permitted ONCE, court and time permitting.
- > Players are expected to act in sportsmanlike conduct in and out of court:
 - ✓ show respect,
 - ✓ be considerate,
 - ✓ avoid conflicts.
- Each player is expected to supply 1 shuttlecock for his/her game.
- Participation in PBC may be considered "terminated" or "Inactive" following an absence of 1-month without prior notice. This will allow those in wait list to be brought in as regular participant.
