Tips, Ideas, and Perspective for Leading Your Group Remotely

- Send out your agenda the night before with questions so women can process a head of time. This will help with the conversational flow of the meeting as well as lag time.
- Follow Up Questions: When making your plan think of questions that will lead to pursuing hearts where you can ask the 2nd question.
- Don't forget One on Ones: set up a phone call, virtual walk/ walk and talk together in your own neighborhood. Be creative one on ones are more needed then you may think or even feel.
- ➤ If you don't already have **group texts** this is a great way for everyone to initiate with one another send your favorite song, verse, quote, blog, encouragement or way to pray for one another
- > 3 Key elements in leading right now are structure, accountability and to pray for one another this will help you feel connected to their community at a deeper level.
- Remember to **grieve** with your women. This is a hard season for many of us. Grieving over different losses. Name them and take them to the Lord together.
- Perspective about zoom calls: it may be hard to be fully present. So, it will take some grace. Enjoy learning and seeing your people's homes and home life, name what's different and continue to share your heart this time you have with them. REMEMBER this time of true fellowship is needed and could be a true lifeline for your people to connect at a deeper level.
