## **Truth: (Mark 12:41-44)**

And he sat down opposite the treasury and watched the people putting money into the offering box. Many rich people put in large sums. And a poor widow came and put in two small copper coins, which make a penny. And he called his disciples to him and said to them, "Truly, I say to you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the offering box. For they all contributed out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, all she had to live on."

## **Equipping: (Discussion questions)**

- 1. How much did the rich people give?** Large sums **How much did the poor widow give?** 2 small copper coins
- 2. How does Jesus know that this woman is a poor widow?** He knew her heart because he was the Son of God.
- 3. What set this specific poor widow apart from other givers?** She was living for God and giving all she had.
- 4. Why does Jesus say this poor widow put more in than all the contributors to the treasury?** She gave all she had, knowing God would provide.
- 5. In what ways did the poor widow reflect Jesus?** Jesus gave everything for us! He died on the cross to cover all of our sins!

## **Accountability:**

- 1. Why would you want to give all you have to God?**
- 2. What are ways you are giving everything to God? What are ways you are not giving everything to God?**

## **Mission:**

- 1. If someone said they wanted to live for God but didn't know how, what would you tell them?**
- 2. Can you think of someone in your life you can serve this week?**

## **Supplication:**

"Dear God, we know you gave us your Word to help us learn how to follow you. Help us commit to putting into practice what we've discovered today about how to live for you. Remind us this week to make choices that honor you. We need your help to stay focused on you and on your ways as we run the race of life. Remind us also that we can show your love to the world in the ways we act, talk, and trust you no matter what. In Jesus' name, amen."
