GATE Transportation Voucher Program Questions and Answers

The GATE (Get Around Town Easily) Transportation Voucher Program offers new and exciting travel opportunities for older adults to go more places of their choice without travel boundaries or time limitations.

Question: Who is eligible to participate in the GATE program?

Residents of Alpharetta, Johns Creek, Milton, Mountain Park, Roswell or Sandy Springs who are older adults 60+, unable to drive or access public transportation are eligible to participate in the GATE program.

Question: How does the GATE voucher program work?

Participants will receive a checkbook style book of vouchers to use as payment for their transportation provider (driver) for one-way trips or roundtrips to a chosen destination. The voucher book has \$10 and \$5 vouchers for a total value of \$100.

The participant and driver will agree on the cost of the trip before the trip is taken. After the trip is completed, the participant and driver will fill out the voucher(s) with the trip information, sign the voucher and send two copies to the Mobility Manager at Senior Services North Fulton. The driver will receive a check for the value of the voucher(s).

Question: Who can be a transportation provider (driver) in the program?

Transportation providers can be friends, family, neighbors or other contacts and may live with the participant. The one exception is the participant's spouse, who cannot be a designated driver under the GATE program.

Question: What is the cost of the voucher books?

The participant can purchase a voucher book containing \$100 worth of vouchers. The cost share for this book is \$25. The participant may purchase a maximum of two voucher books before December 31, 2013 but must use all the vouchers in the first book before purchasing the next book.

Question: What is the first step to applying for the GATE program?
