



Student Leaders Ministry Covenant

We are held to a higher accountability when we enter into ministry. Therefore, keeping the Ministry Covenant means you are striving to have a Christ-reliant life and ministry. At times we will fail in thought, speech, and action, but we are made righteous by God's grace and we grow as the Holy Spirit works in our lives.

1 Timothy 4:12

“Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity.”

Speech: I will engage in honest and encouraging communication. I will refrain from damaging speech. This includes gossip, slandering, cursing, and unwise subject matter. I will communicate with those I minister to and am ministered by. Therefore I will regularly attend a local church worship service and be active in their student ministry.

Life: I will live a life that reflects my belief in Jesus Christ. I will seek to be a person of biblical integrity. I will live humbly, thinking of others before myself and seek the input of other believers to sharpen my walk. I further understand that as a person of biblical integrity, I will abstain from the use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, and other mood altering substances.

Love: I will cultivate my relationship with Jesus through daily contact with Him. I will support the ministry of the church. I will reach out to those in my path with the saving hope of Christ.

Faith: I will hold to the teachings of the church. I will not intentionally persuade or teach material & information that is inconsistent with the statements of belief of Perimeter church and the BRICKS.

Purity: I understand purity to mean fidelity in thought, word, and action. I understand that sexual behavior has a direct and unique impact on my ministry and my testimony. I will not engage in the use of pornographic material and in any sexual activity except in the God ordained context of marriage.

The purpose of the BRICKS ministry is to ENGAGE the Jr. High students of our community WITH the Good News of Jesus Christ in caring for their spiritual and physical needs.

We try to accomplish this by concentrating on the following:
