Ps. 141:1-4

*Hear my voice when I call to you.*

*2 May my prayer be set before you like incense;*

*may the lifting up of my hands be like the evening sacrifice.*

*3 Set a guard over my mouth, O LORD;*

*keep watch over the door of my lips.*

*4 Let not my heart be drawn to what is evil*

*to take part in wicked deeds*

*with men who are evildoers;*

*let me not eat of their delicacies.*

Ps. 141: 5a

*Let a righteous man strike me—it is a kindness;*

*let him rebuke me—it is oil on my head.*

*My head will not refuse it.*
