Basic Food Needs Met



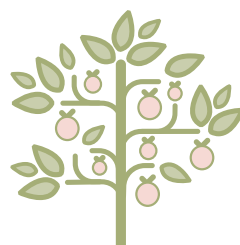
Paychecks can go towards car and rent
